### Note from the Safety Officer.

I draw your attention to Regulation 4.8 of the current Club Flying Rules, which states that: "If more than one aircraft is operating on the runway, all flying to be in a rectangular circuit."

Obviously, in order to avoid head on collisions, all circuits should be either clockwise or ant-clockwise a viewed from above. It is permissible to perform loops or rolls or other manoeuvres

in the rectangles, provided that they do not affect the flight rectangle of other fliers.

It has been observed that some fliers have been attempting different manoeuvres in the middle of the

rectangle, such as 3D stunts and the like, which may cause collisions and damage to other models. Please make sure that you do not offend in this way.

### Webmaster

The more observant amongst you would have noticed the webcams have changed recently. After 11 years we have finally been able to upgrade the Internet at the club. We have always had ADSL 1 (ADSL 2 was not available) and the speed of the internet for the webcams & weather station was atrocious. In late January I was able to get NBN installed. What a difference!

With the extra bandwidth I have now increased the resolution (size of the video) to double the original size & increased the frame rate (number of images per second) so you should find the webcams bigger & faster.

For the nerdier amongst you, previously on ADSL 1 the best upload speed (webcams upload to the internet, not download as most things are in your homes) I ever saw was 0.5 Mbs, average however was a lot lower, some days 0.1 Mbs. I'm now getting uploads of around 5-7Mbs.

The new bandwidth usage is quite significant. Each day I'm now seeing around 1GB of data usage on the system, with the highest being 2.4GB on Saturday's in case you're wondering.

You guys have obviously noticed the upgrade and are giving the system a workout.

I am planning on more upgrades to the overall system in the coming months & I'll keep you updated via the newsletter.
