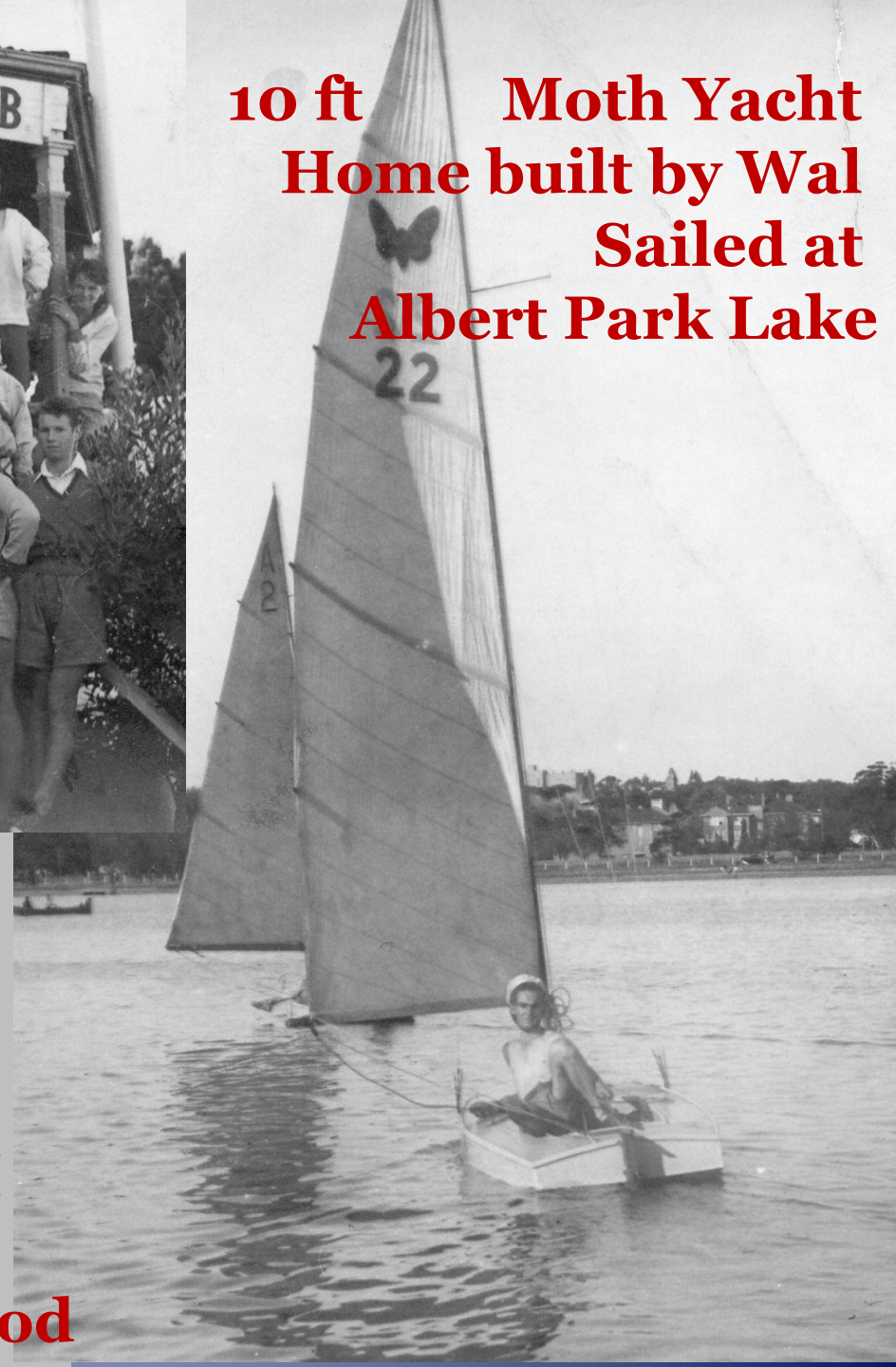

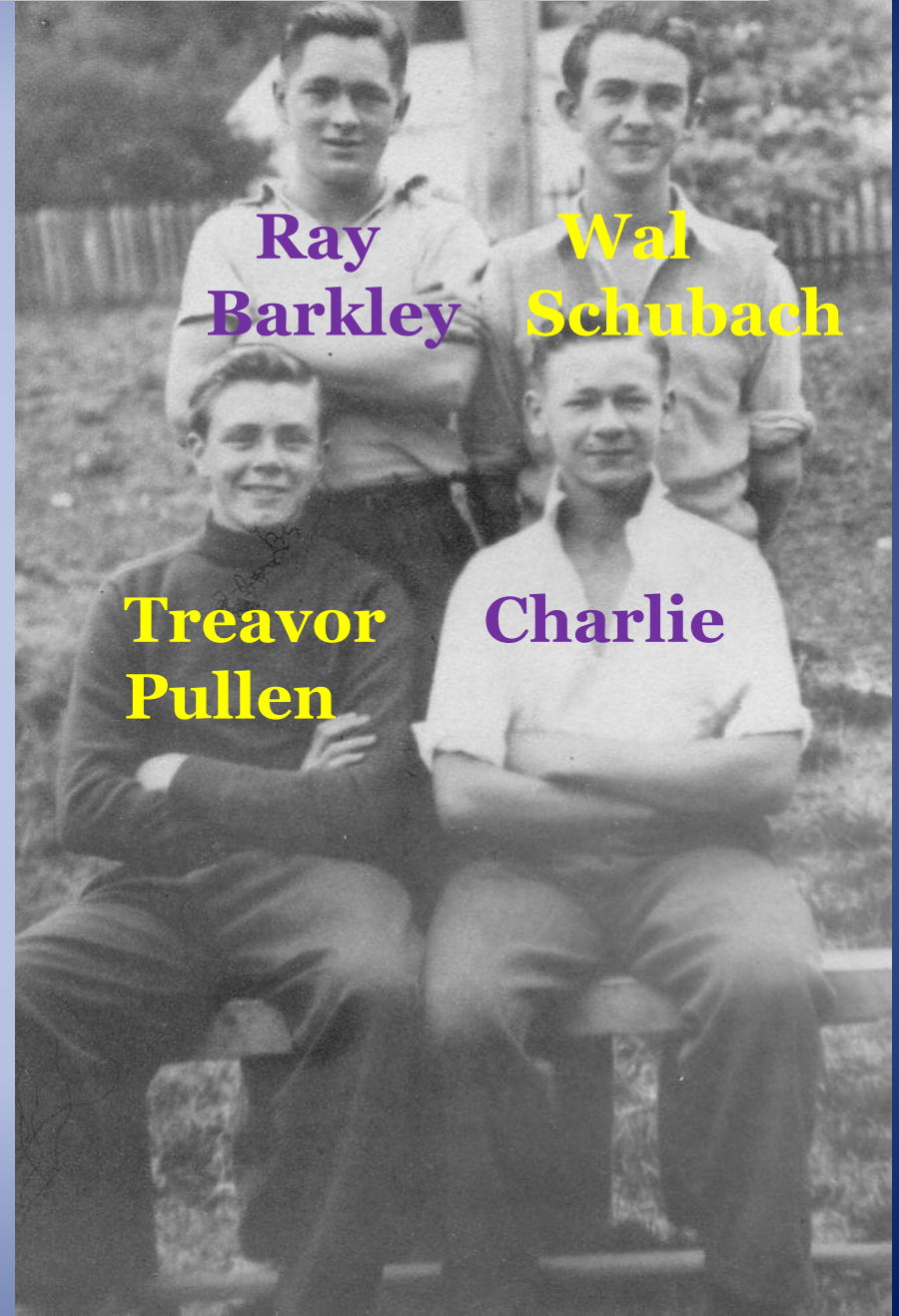


Wal owned a series of Fords including this XB Falcon. One of his cars he had for 33 years.
